## Abstract:

The words "focused, rigorous, coherent" describe mathematics curricula, but are inadequate for describing what it *feels* like to teach or learn from such a curriculum. I will describe the Eureka Math Curriculum as an epic story that travels through: A Story of Units (PK-5), A Story of Ratios (6-8), A Story of Functions (9-12).
